



MYSTIC SOUNDS

2016 Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc

Background

Mystic Sounds wines are the result of painstaking attention to detail in both vineyard and winery from the pinnacle of New Zealand wine regions, Marlborough. This Sauvignon Blanc was carefully nurtured following vintage and the components held separately. The wine undergoes extended contact with skins and some lees stirring during fermentation on exotic yeast strains. These techniques have worked together to create this unique example of New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc.

Tasting Notes

Pungently aromatic, Mystic Sounds New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc assails the senses with red capsicum (bell pepper) and gooseberry characters through lush passionfruit and tropical fruit overtones. Other notes include fresh cut grass, tomato stalks, grapefruit or limes. Mystic Sounds Sauvignon Blanc's 'zing' is a delightful complement to the fresh flavours of seafood, shellfish and white fish. Enhance the effect with citrus or garlic based sauces. Crunchy summer salads and capsicums resonate with the flavours of Sauvignon Blanc; both the wine and the dish are flattered by the match. Tangy foods, such as tomatoes and vinegar based dressings, are other sympathetic matches. On its own, Sauvignon Blanc is a mouth-watering aperitif.
